BRAC Workforce Analysis
 June 29, 2007 - DRAFT

The Susquehanna Workforce Network (SWN) recently completed an analysis of BRAC-related workforce issues. With the assistance of a consulting team, the network identified the workforce skill sets of the **Department of Defense (DoD) and Embedded Contractor** BRAC occupations that are scheduled to relocate to Aberdeen Proving Ground to include: occupational classifications, requirements and skill needs.

Logistics & Acquisition Partners, LLC; The Robinson Group Strategic Communications, LLC; and A Bright Idea, LLC began the study in April, 2007 and a report was provided to SWN on May 28, 2007. The team also assisted SWN in developing public outreach materials that will make the BRAC related information more accessible to the public. The network will be posting the occupations information on their web site: www.swnetwork.org

The analysis reported that the **DoD and embedded civilian contractors** estimate the following number of positions to relocate to Aberdeen Proving Ground.

Note: The estimates that follow do not include non-embedded contractor positions and tertiary job growth.
